New Medicare cards will be issued

*Be sure Medicare has your correct mailing address by calling <u>1-800-medicare</u>.

WHEN? Beginning April 2018 through end of 2019

WHY? For YOUR security – Medicare is....

Replacing Social Security numbers on your card With random digits and letters

What is the SCAM - A phone call or email stating...

"You will lose Medicare benefits if you don't get the new card"

- You must pay for your new card
- Asks you to verify your existing Medicare #
- Congress requires a fee for the new card
- Fee must come out of your checking account
- Requests your checking account # and bank information

The Center for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)

will never call or email you requesting personal information.

The new Medicare card will be mailed to you at no charge.
